

Announcement of the Phrayun Provincial Police Station on the Anti-Bribery Policy

According to the Organic Act on Anti-Corruption B.E. 2561(2018)Section 128, paragraph one, prohibits government officials from accepting any asset or other benefit that can be calculated as money from anyone, except for assets or benefits that should be received under the law, regulations or rules issued under the provisions of the law, except for the acceptance of assets or other benefits by virtue of ethics, according to the criteria and amount specified by the National Anti-Corruption Commission, and the Code of Ethics for Police Officers B.E. 2564 (2021) Article 2 (2) being honest, performing duties according to laws, regulations and procedures of the Royal Thai Police with transparency, not exhibiting behavior that implies seeking undue benefit, responsible for human rights duties, ready to be inspected and accountable, having good conscience, considering society, and Article 2 (4) prioritizing the public interest over personal interest, having a public mind, cooperating, united, and sacrificing to benefit the public and create well-being for society. In addition, the National Strategy on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised) specifies an important reform activity, Activity 4: Develop the Thai bureaucratic system to be transparent and free from vested interests, Goal 1, Item 1.1, requiring all government agencies to declare themselves as agencies where all government officials do not accept any gifts or gratuities of any kind from the performance of duties (No Gift Policy)

Therefore, in order to prevent conflicts between personal benefits and the Conflict of Interest). Accepting the bribing of the qualifications or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties. Phra Yuen Yuen Police Station Therefore specifying guidelines for anti-bribery (Anti-Bribery Policy) has the following detailsobjective

1. To prevent or reduce the opportunity to receive bribes Benefits overlapping in various forms for civil servantsPolice under the Phra Yuen Provincial Police Station
2. To encourage the government officials under the Provincial Police Station There is a feeling of rejecting.Receive gifts and of all kinds of duties.
3. To create a culture, organization, morality and transparency (Organization of Integrity) of the systemStrong and sustainable government
4. To determine measures, guidelines and mechanisms to prevent/accepting bribes or any other benefits.
5. To determine the guidelines for receiving the certificate. Or gifts of executives and government officials underPhra Yuen Yuen Police Station To be in accordance with the laws and regulations related
6. YuenDefinition

"Bribe" means property or other benefits that are given to the person for that person to act or Except for any action in the position, regardless of whether it is like or illegal According to the bribery payment, including receiving the gift of the qualifications Facilities Bestwide display, donation, raising and benefits in the same way When the proposal or receiving that can be considered as a result is a bribe. And including giving or receiving later

Gift, tribute, or other benefit that affects the performance of dutiesAssets, services or other benefits of value, including tips, received by government officials in addition to salary, income, and benefits in the normal course of government service, and which influence decision-making, approval, permission, or any other act in the performance of duties in a manner that benefits the gift giver, whether in the past, present, or future

'Assets' means property and intangible objects that may have value and can be possessed, such as money, houses, cars, stocksMoney, houses, cars, stocks'Receiving assets or other benefits in good

'faith' means receiving assets or benefitsOther than relatives or persons who give on various occasions, normally according to customs, traditions or culture, or given according to social

etiquette'Relatives' means ancestors, descendants, siblings of the same parents, or the same father or mother, unclesAunts, nieces, nephews, spouses, ancestors or descendants of spouses, adopted children or adoptive parents

'Other benefits' means things of value, such as discounts, entertainment, servicesReceiving training, or anything else of a similar nature

'Performing duties' means an act or performance of duties of a government officialThe position that has been appointed or assigned to perform one function or another, or to act in place of the official duties, both in general and specifically as a police officer whose powers and duties have been defined by law or to act according to the powers and duties stipulated by law for the police.

'Commanding Officer' means the person with the authority to order, supervise, monitor and inspect. Police officers under the jurisdiction.

'Subordinate' means all police officers under the jurisdiction of Phrayuen Police Station.

Other than the Commanding OfficerGuidelines for prevention of bribery

1. Prohibiting government officials under the police station. Giving or accepting all types of bribes, whether directly or indirectly

2. Do not allow government officials under the police station, Phra Yuen, Phra Yuen, all calls or bribery to Personal benefits or benefits of other people

3. To comply with the anti -corruption policy Growing does not get involved in corruption.

4. Work in duties to comply with the regulations, discipline, police and Related laws Strictly

5. Do not do anything. Which is considered to be given or accepting bribes

6. Supervise to proceed with the expenditure of the agency under Strictly relevant laws

7. Donation or financial support, whether money or property For any activities or projects Must comply with regulations and regulations And have a receipt or evidence Accepting the report of the report every time

8. Receiving assets or other benefits by Dharma, the government officials under the Phra Yuen Police Station, every office to comply with the announcement. The National Counter Corruption Commission regarding the rules for receiving property or other benefits by the Dharma of the Officer B.E. 2563 strictly.

Policy violation measures

1. The violation of this policy may be disciplined or proceeding with criminal cases or other relevant laws. Including direct supervisors who ignore the wrongdoing or acknowledge that there is an offense but does not properly manage Which has disciplinary punishment to the point of being fired from the government

2. Not being aware of this policy announcement and/or related laws cannot Can be used as an excuse to not follow

3. The supervisor according to the order of the Department of Police 1212/2537, dated October 1, 1994, with the authority to look after the subordinates in the rule to strictly adhere to and comply with this policy.

Monitoring and Inspection Measures

1. The Superintendent of the Phrayuen Police Station declared his intention to administer the organization with honesty, integrity, transparency, and in accordance with good governance principles, by publicizing this to the police officers under his command and external stakeholders

2. The commanding officers as per Police Department Order No. 1212/2537 dated 1 October 1994 are empowered to oversee, monitor, and inspect the subordinate police officers under their jurisdiction to ensure their compliance with this announcement. In case of any violations, they are to report promptly to the Superintendent of the Phrayuen Police Station

3. The Provincial Police Station of Phra Yuen arranged for a review and improvement of the guidelines for practice in accordance with the appropriateness or changes in various significant factors

4. The Operations Division of the Provincial Police Station of Phra Yuen shall compile statistical data on the acceptance of bribes or gifts or any other benefits from the performance of duties, together with problems and obstacles, and report to the Station Commander of the Provincial Police Station of Phra Yuen on a quarterly basis

Measures to protect the complainant/clue and secret treatment

1. Consideration of complaints Define secrets and protect relevant parties in accordance with regulations Regarding the security of the government, 2001 and sending the matter to the department to consider Information giveers and the petitioner may have suffered, such as complaints for civil servants in the beginning to be considered a government secret. Consider only the evidence The environment is clear, as well as indicating only the witnesses. The influential clue must conceal the name and address of the petitioner. If not concealing the name of the petitioner, the relevant agencies must be informed and covered to the petitioner as follows. "Have the supervisor use the discretion as appropriate to protect the petitioner, witnesses and people who provide information on the investigation, do not have to be disaster or the cause of complaints. To witness or providing information. "In the event that the accused is specified, the petitioner must protect both the petitioner and the singer. Because the

matter has not been passed through the investigation process and may be bullying to suffer and damage. And in the case of the petitioner specifying in the request, concealing or does not wish to reveal the name of the complainant The agency must not reveal the name of the petitioner to the authorities because the petitioner may have suffered according to the incident of that complaint.

2. When there is a complaint, the complainant and witnesses will not be subjected to any actions that affect their work duties or livelihood. If any action is necessary, such as separating the workplace to prevent the complainant, witness and the accused from meeting, it must be with the consent of the complainant and witness.

3. Requests from the victim, complainant or witness, such as a request to change the workplace or methods for prevention or problem-solving, should be duly considered by the responsible person or agency.

4. Protect the complainant from retaliation.
